GROTON UNITED METHODIST CHURCH HISTORY

In January 1886 the Methodist Episcopals held a series of meetings in their church in Farmington Township. Officials were contacted and a minister was requested for Groton. Dr. A.D. Traveler, presiding elder of Dakota Territory, wrote to the college where Wm. J. Hyde was a senior. In July 1886, Hyde arrived and held the first M.E. service in the Presbyterian Church. He then arranged to hold services in the G.A.R. hall (a room over a saloon, reached by an outside ladder). The pews were planks on nail kegs and the only hymnal was the pastor's. Much history is recorded in Rev. Hyde's book, <u>Dig or Die, Brother Hyde</u>.

Rev. Hyde held services in homes and schools, as well as the meeting place, but by fall 1887, he wanted his own church. He raised most of the funds himself, getting contributions from farmers and businessmen, and a building was built on the site where the Groton Community Center now stands. The itemized bill for all materials totalled \$707.87. The Church was dedicated Dec. 18, 1897.

Hyde moved to a room on the second floor of the Church. He married in 1888, and Mrs. Hyde and other women of the Church raised money by sewing and holding social events. Hyde left in October 1888, not knowing where he would be sent next. The Church then had 67 members.

By the 1890's the Sunday School had an average attendance of 76 people and officers. The Epworth League and Ladies Aid Society were organized in 1892. The first parsonage was built where Paetznick Garness Funeral Chapel stands, and Rev. Sanderson was the first to live in it. The next parsonage was built east of the Church in 1900. The congregation outgrew Hyde's Church and in 1911 a brick structure was erected. The Church with \$5000 debt remaining was dedicated on Dec. 3, 1911.

In 1939 many Methodist groups united and the Methodist Episcopal Church and the Ladies Aid changed their names to the Methodist Church and the Woman's Society of Christian Service. In 1968 the Methodist Church and the Evangelical United Brethren Churches merged to become the United Methodist Church and the Ladies became United Methodist Women.

Fund raising began in 1950 under Rev. MacKinzie, for a new Church. A city block was donated for the Church at its present site. Ground breaking and consecration took place Nov. 19, 1961, with Rev. Nielsen presiding. The first stage, an educational unit and temporary sanctuary, was completed and consecrated June 17, 1962, with Rev. Sanders. The second stage, the sanctuary, was started in 1966 and consecrated April 7, 1968, with Rev. Brekke. A new parsonage was built and consecrated in 1971 when Rev. Moore was pastor. The dedication and mortgage burning ceremony was on Oct. 4, 1981.

At various times Groton shared a minister and expenses with the Bath and Andover Churches and is currently with the Columbia Congregational U.C.C.

In the early years pastors moved often. Following Rev. Hyde were: C.S. Fowler, David Gostelow, John A. Ellis, W.D. Deeble, F.T. MacDuffee, Thomas Sanderson, P. Ingersol, O.W. Butterfield, Louis L. Lane, S.E. Brown, C. Benson, Fred G. MacKenzie, Harvey Sander, Robert P. Nielsen, K. Oliver Brekke, Larry Moore, John Maines, Jack Erickson, Wayne Tieszen, and Dean Trapp, the present pastor.




