- Easter Sunday March 27 with a Sunrise service at 7:30 am with breakfast and 11:00 am worship service.







Groton Lenten Schedule

The original plan for the February meeting was to invite guests and have a special meal and program, but because of the Lenten Meals, it was decided to just have a regular meeting after the Service.


Pat Siefken will have the lesson entitled, "Foundations of Blessedness". Joan Fahrenwald will serve a dessert lunch.

Anniversaries and Birthdays

Groton Ad Council - Jan

Anita Lowary explained how the Highway 37 project will affect our church property. The state will pay Groton UMC \$1385.00 for a temporary easement to raise the ditch and run drainage along our property. The state will also pay Groton UMC \$800 for property in the NW corner of our property to be used for installation of a water drain that will connect to the sewer. The board approved the easement proposal and sale pending approval by the Trustees.

Pastor Thomas explained that he is currently working on his under graduate degree and seminary. He also shared an itemized report of his visits and attendance at events for the board to review as well as outlined his goals for visits, contacts, and e-mails going forward. Trustees: Marjorie Overacker reported that the stained glass windows have been appraised for insurance purposes with a replacement cost of \$45,500. She also reviewed the insurance company's requirement for locking certain doors and the need to lock up a few miscellaneous items within the church.

Kid's Ministry: Angela Dobbins reported that her three main goals are: organization, communication, and forming a list of students. Both Angela and Pastor Thomas want to see the Sunday school office cleaned & organized.

Funeral Setups: After discussion on the costs of using paper and plastic in place of china at funeral meals, the board voted that all funeral meals in the future will use paper & plastic products.
