
We hope these kids take what they have learned and share with everyone! I know my kids can't wait to go back to the Surf Shack next year!





Little Free Library will soon be full of books again! Summer Story time will be at 9:30 am on Thursday June 9th through July 28th.


New this year is a battery operated candle inside that will automatically turn on to light our library in the evenings!

Groton UMW - May

Vice President Gloria Pharis opened the meeting with 13 members in attendance. Gloria introduced Jeanne Wanous who shared information about the twoweek UMC General Conference in Portland, OR. She explained that the conference is held every four years for the purpose of revising church law. UMW representatives in attendance include the UMW Board of Directors and Program Advisors who are elected as general delegates and key members of the UMW national office staff. UMW women gathered at the conference to mark their 150th Anniversary coming in 2019. Jeanne shared that the UMW petitioned the General Conference with four new priority areas: 1) Climate Justice, 2) Maternal and Child Health, 3) Ending Mass Incarceration, and (4 Economic Inequality.

Following Jeanne's report, members recited the UMW Purpose followed by the business meeting.

Minutes from the April meeting were read & approved. There was no correspondence. Jeanne gave the Treasurer's Report showing an ending balance of \$2,978.63. She included a financial preliminary report of the May Luncheon which shows a profit of \$970. Advertising bills have not been received, but once paid the estimated profit will be \$915 compared to \$942 in 2015. A total of 111 luncheon plates were sold compared to 116 in 2015.

Old Business: Discussion was held regarding the 2016 May Luncheon. Diane Morehouse and daughters-in-law were thanked for their decorations and dessert ideas. One suggestion made to attract more men to attend would be to invite the Kiwanis group to hold their meeting in one of our side rooms and they could partake of our salad luncheon at the same time. The group consensus was that the luncheon was a success and we should plan the salad luncheon again for 2017.

New Business: Jeanne shared the story of 7-year old Drake Dosch, son of Jeremy Dosch and Kelsie Ehresmann of Columbia, and nephew of Myndi Kampa, who has been dealing with years of health issues. A Go Fund Me effort has been started to help raise funds to build a School/Therapy House in Drake's yard. After hearing about this project Jan Raap motioned that our UMW donate \$100 toward the fundraiser. Valerie Baker 2nd the motion and the motion carried.

The group approved sending our annual pledge to missions, a gift in memory to missions in honor Jean Lowary, and sending in our annual World Thank Offering. These are three of the Five-Star giving challenges for each UMW group.

Kay Daly shared a catalog of various cards that we can select to replenish the UMW card stock we currently have for sale. Kay will place an order soon, as the last replenishment was in 2014.

Gloria reviewed our upcoming meeting schedule and reminded all that our next meeting is scheduled to be held at the Golden Living Center with refreshments to follow at the Dairy Queen. Please watch bulletin announcements for confirmation of details.

The meeting ended with a prayer given by Jeanne Wanous asking that our children throughout the world may see the love of the Lord in the people around them and that they may experience his peace.

Fellowship followed the meeting with a rhubarb dessert and coffee served by Jan Raap and Jeanne Wanous.

Groton Ad Council - May

Six members of the administrative council met on May 18. They were pleased to hear that 65 children attended the recent Vacation Bible School held in conjunction with Emmanuel Lutheran Church, with over half of the children being United Methodist.

Kristi Peterson, our new church treasurer, and Pastor Thomas reported on their visit with the conference treasurer in Mitchell. A new format for the monthly treasurer's report was reviewed with the conference treasurer and approved. Kristi shared the new report with the Ad Council.

The council approved a 5-year financial commitment to the Thrive Campaign

of \$10/week over a 5-year period which will total \$2600.

The council discussed use of personal church member's recent donations of money for parsonage specific projects to include driveway improvements to prevent water leakage into the basement, installation of basement egress windows to adhere to insurance requirements, pouring of a back patio, and lawn care needs. Suggested projects will need to be approved by the Board of Trustees and the Pastor/Parish Committee.

Finally, the council voted to suspend regular monthly Ad Council meetings for June & July, with the next scheduled meeting to occur on August 17, 2016.
