Hello Church Family,

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest

Matthew 11:28

In the early 1940s the US government contacted Steinway and Son's Piano Company and asked them to prototype a piano that they could drop to the troops that were fighting. Two years later, in 1942, they came back with a 455pound piano, a lot smaller than a normal sized piano, but one that they were able to take and drop (even at times behind enemy lines) for our troops on the field to gather in evenings around a piano to sing.

They called these victory verticals and we dropped about 2500 of them! When one person was asked, "Why in the world would you do this?" Steinway and Son's said. "Music is an excellent way of keeping men from going insane in the horrors of war and from homesickness. These pianos played an important role in providing soldiers with countless hours of diversion, education, entertainment, and



worship."

You and I, we carry so much responsibility each day: balancing work, family, bills... not to mention our own mental health! And there are weeks where I find myself in awe of just how broken our world is... how heavy my heart feels and how exhausted it makes me. When I heard this story, I thought to myself, "There are days when I need a piano dropped in the middle of my house! In the middle of my commute! In the middle of my meetings!" Anyone with me?

Worship is so powerful because when we seek His presence, He arrives and things change... We are able to rise above our circumstances and remember that He is not only in control of this whole world,

but that He loves us dearly.

My hope for you this summer, is that in the midst of all you devote your time to, you find time for worship. Even if it is in quiet moments throughout the day. Our souls long for it, and He is worthy of it.


Sunday School - Groton



Attendance: Pastor Brandon, Allen Walter, Lars Hanson, Marge Overacker, Meri Erickson, Anita Lowary, Linda Thurston, and Val Baker

Call meeting to order at 7:05 – Lars Hanson

Agenda approved on a motion by Linda Thurston, seconded by Anita Lowary.

Previous Minutes approved on a motion by Val Baker, seconded by Anita Lowary.

Committee Reports:

Trustees: Pastor Brandon stated that tree at parsonage has been taken down by Tyke Nyberg and Randy Stanley. Marc Johnson provided the equipment. - Pastor Brandon has been accepted into seminary starting the first of June.
- Pastor will be gone in June the following dates: Gone June 9-11, June 12 at Lake Poinsett to help with a camp, June 19 at Wesley Acres as a camp counselor.
- Pastor Brandon also reported that Kathy Zoellner Engel will be presenting during church services in Groton on May 22. She lives in Warsaw, Poland, and will be talking about her experiences in Warsaw and the effects of the war.
- Anita made the motion to donate \$100 to Kathy for the refugees in

Poland. Linda Thurston seconded it. There will also be a freewill donation during church services.

Old Business:

Pastor spoke to the Conde church and they are willing to move their church service to 8:30 a.m. That would move Groton's service to 10:30 a.m. Discussed having Sunday school during church, with the exception of Communion Sunday. This move has been brought up by several people. Pastor Brandon will mention this move in church and put it in the newsletter, encouraging people to give their feedback. Lars will review the feedback and get information to the committee. Pending feedback, the tentative date for change would be June 19.

Missions: Val Baker shared that May baskets will be assembled next Sunday morning for Rosewood Court. Treasurer's Report:

Church Treasurer: Marjorie Overacker stated that our funds are still looking good and that we should consider making monthly apportionment payments again. After some discussion, Allen Walter motioned that we resume apportionment payments at 25% of the total sum for the time being. Anita Lowary 2nd the motion and the motion was passed.
